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Good afternoon all.

The toolkit that Laura sent you is in the process of being updated. There will be a virtual training on it in June. There is training available for your staff to conduct retail tobacco inspections (currently being offered) and compliance checks (offered in June). Recruitment is always a challenge in many areas of the state. I have attached the job description that MHOA uses when we are recruiting youth to work with our tobacco agents. Once you have recruited an underage buyer there is a video training available.

If your inspector wants to put the Bellingham data into the state database, as previous inspectors have done let me know and I can send you that training information also.
