I am writing to you as a courtesy to let you know that on November 3, 2025, the Dover Board of Health voted to adopt a Nicotine Free Generation policy. This means that anyone born on or after January 1, 2005, can never buy tobacco within the Town of Dover, regardless of when they reach the legal age to purchase these products.

The goal of this policy is to prevent youth from adopting nicotine and tobacco use, as the majority of these addictions start at a young age. We felt it important to share this with you, as you work with these individuals each and every day. We appreciate your support as we move forward with this new initiative.
