Apply to become a certified Massachusetts Department of Public Health Sexual Assault Nurse Examiner (SANE) and join a team of regionally based, part-time contractors, who provide trauma-informed 1:1 care with flexible on-call hours and competitive on-call pay.

WHO

Registered Nurses or Advanced Practice Nurses, licensed in Massachusetts, with a minimum of three years of experience. We encourage nurses with diverse backgrounds to apply. All nursing specialties welcome.

Training begins March 26, 2026, with seven LIVE VIRTUAL sessions 9AM – 1PM
