- *** MassNotify, the official COVID-19 exposure notification system for Massachusetts was discontinued with the end of the federal COVID-19 public health emergency on May 11, 2023.** The public is still encouraged to follow the Massachusetts Department of Public Health COVID-19 guidance.
- *** The Department of Conservation and Recreation is hiring lifeguards. DCR is offering bonuses and an hourly wage of \$22-27 an hour.** Lifeguards must be at least 16 years old, have completed lifeguard training, and be certified in first aid and CPR.
