Survey demographics (12/18/24)

- **146 EHS students**

- **Grade:** pretty even split among grades, fewer 11th graders
 - **Gender identity:** 44% cis girls, 40% cis boys, 10% trans/nonbinary, 8 % not sure/identify in another way
 - **Sexual orientation:** 65% straight, 27% LGB+, 8% not sure
 - **Race:** 87% white, 11% Latinx, 8% Asian, 4% Black
