Hey Ryan,

Yesterday, I met with the student group working on the Nicotine-Free Generation project for the Board of Health. Beyond this point, I'm taking a hands-off approach to let them work without appearing to guide them toward a specific outcome.

This year, Mrs. Brown taught them about preemption ceilings, floors, and vacuums, so they are aware of the implications of the Supreme Court case in Massachusetts and the public health allowances granted to municipalities to exceed the stated minimum. About 12 students are working on the project, and I believe 2 will attend our meeting on their behalf.

Once the meeting information is published, I'll send it to Mrs. Brown so her student can log in. In that same vein, the reading group is going great so far. The Health Department is well-represented at the school :)
