I completed the first pass on this and will review it with Simone tomorrow. In general, our goal is to meet all of the minimums. We routinely touch base with the MDPH and MDEP to assess how we can and should improve. We have separate staff that specialize in inspections and complaints, environmental and regulatory compliance, nursing and health care, wells and septic and administrative compliance and permitting. In 2024, we were doing well with extra nursing/staffing assistance. We try to do everything in house. We lean on our medical supervisors, Board, SS, FD, PD and Y&F Services. Our strategic plan requires us to keep tabs on all of our civic, church and community partners.

I'm data driven, so I'm in the DEP, Energy and Affairs and DPH data portals at least every other day. Hopkinton residents are tough. I have to know my numbers. Later in 2024 I had to "furlough" my extra per diem staff. HR and I have been battling. The old TM was trying to fire me. It was brutal but we persevered.

We are developing new programs for the state. We are assisting them with new laws. We are going to NFG in a month or so. We have been distributing Narcan and Fentanyl test kits for years. We are one of the largest distributors of test kits in the Commonwealth.

I don't use the Collaborative for much...financial. Occasional social service work.

That is why I justified the higher scores/ratings. That being said, I rated us Moderate for the apple cart will be flipped if one or two of us departs. We are stretched thin.
