Thank you for bringing up that topic 'NFG -Nicotine Free Generation'. I am glad that you are interested to adopt NFG policy in Hopkinton. I was about to discuss with all the Health Directors in our collaborative in the upcoming Annual meeting.

As of now, 6 communities in MA have adopted the policy. Brookline passed it as a bylaw in 2020. Stoneham, Wakefield, Melrose, Winchester and Malden have adopted this policy.
