Hello Neha,

My name is Julie Coco and I am the Internship Coordinator for the [Local Health Internship Program](#). Shaun forwarded me your email with the questions, so I am hoping that I can be helpful. The Local Health Internship Program is available for all students (enrolled or accepted into a degree-seeking program). Additionally, they must be a U.S. citizen or have appropriate employment authorization documents and at least the minimum age required by state law for employment standards.

I have attached this year's offerings to give you an idea of the opportunities that are typically available for students (e.g., community health needs assessments, environmental sampling, data analysis, tobacco control education, etc.).

The applications typically open in February (and are on the website link above) and close mid-March. The applicants are selected by the end of April and the program runs all summer. The program is 160 hours of required hours. It is typically hybrid, although some sites do require students to be in-person and there are typically 1-3 completely remote opportunities (aside from the in-person closing ceremony). The internship this year is paid, but we are unsure of the status of funding for future cohorts.
