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Meeting began at 10:03am.

1. Jen Ford welcomed all. Lieutenant Joe Thibodeau and Officer Meghan Hudson were in attendance. Laura Miranda hosted a "Mindful Minute."
2. The October 2024 minutes were reviewed and accepted.
3. Det. Lucci received underage drinking party tips. The junior and senior classes, in particular, are sharing parties. There has been reported vaping in the 8<sup>th</sup> grade wing and on the bus. The school is enforcing the 1-in-1-out policy. He is investigating a case regarding an adult providing marijuana to a middle schooler.
4. Detective Hanley reported no new overdoses. He also reported on scam awareness.
5. Laura reminded us it is a difficult time of the year for many and referrals continue. The Mental Wellness Action is continuing their book club.
6. Eleanor Richard shared the Noggins & Noodles is refiguring the "Spring Semester." 2 Naloxone trainings are coming up.
7. Jen reported that the Steering Committee is re-connecting with each other.
8. Amy happily reported that Adam Taylor (6<sup>th</sup> grade) and Michael Fisher (8<sup>th</sup> grade) are the new co-student representatives to the Coalition and are onboarding tonight with their parents. Jen may have 2 high school students as well.
9. Laura and Amy Luckiewicz have a reach out plan for Peer Recovery Coaches. Laura will call and/or email all contacts who may benefit since 2018. Amy will include PRC info at the end of press releases with Laura's info. She is also considering investing some funds in targeted marketing. Valerie Taylor suggested reaching out to St. Teresa's, Congregational and Trinity churches for their AA meetings.
10. Amy and Det. Lucci completed fall semester 7<sup>th</sup> grade marijuana education with 63 students and 8<sup>th</sup> grade alcohol education with 54. Amy noted that of all the students only 2 knew family rules about substance use.
11. Amy reported Dr. Daly may re-consider diversion next school year.
12. Marci attended an online marijuana education in Rockport and recommends.
13. The next meeting will be our annual celebration and election results breakfast!
