I think we have a team meeting scheduled for this coming Monday evening, but I didn't want to wait until then to give you the date for Hopkinton's public hearing: **Wednesday May 14, 6:45PM, Hopkinton Town Hall**. Please mark your calendars. It may be hybrid, I'm not sure. I plan to attend in person.

I just got off a Zoom meeting with two members of the Hopkinton DFC grant who support the work of the local 84 chapter (youth!). And three members of Baystate CS, which supports Community Partnership programming in the Hopkinton area. Four were brand new to me but

one I know from a past life and she's very excited to have a chance to work on an important public health policy again and stated that emphatically to the group.

Most have never attended a public hearing, and two of the five were brand new to their positions so we did an overview of the policy, a bit of NFG history/progress, what to expect from a public hearing, pushback, etc.

I sent them assorted documents and sample letters, which they requested.

Hope many of you can attend to testify in person; or to testify virtually if that is an option; or to submit written testimony if you're not available on the 14th.

I'll let you know if I get more details such as time limit for each speaker. The chair seemed pretty capable at running a meeting so I'm sure she'll do fine with the hearing.
