Hi Anthony,

Thanks so much for your message! Please find the updated data set, attached. We are now up to 87 responses after I re-contacted all towns that were yet to respond.

I certainly appreciate your point regarding sending the survey to all towns at once. Unfortunately, due to limitations in personnel working on compiling a database of emails for all municipalities, it took us about 2 months to build the complete database of health director and board member contacts; in hopes of getting responses as rapidly as possible, we decided to send out the survey in stages to the contacts we did have, rather than wait for the complete database to be complete. Luckily, at this point we now have a pretty complete email database, so in re-contacting towns I have been able to contact all towns at once! Of course, given the relatively low response rate to each survey wave, even when all towns are contacted at the same time it may deceptively appear from the data that only a few towns were contacted each survey wave. I hope that helps clarify!

I would be happy to attend tomorrow evening if someone might be able to pass along the time and virtual link to the meeting?
