First, I would like to thank you for presenting the Nicotine Free Generation regulatory concept to the Natick Board of Health back in February.

Your presentation kindled additional interest in pursuing this regulatory strategy.

To that end, I was hoping you could provide me some additional information.

In general, some questions I had include:

- How many communities have adopted the NFG regulation and how many are estimated to consider adopting?
- The MA Supreme Court has upheld the NFG regulation. Is this being challenged in Federal Court?
- What process has been used to implement this regulation? My understanding is that Brookline implemented this as a By-Law. If we move forward, the intent would be as a revision to our Tobacco control Regulations.

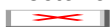
Please feel free to forward me any information you have and I will ensure the Board has it for review.
