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Jonathan,

A few thoughts for the FAQ:

1. Addressing the "why do we need this when we are at an all time low in smoking among youth"--the result of getting to zero is just as much public health policy (if not more) as education. We see youth rates increase when new products come out. This is a proactive approach against the industry.
2. No avenue for appeal or route to the Supreme Court at this time. BoH not only have the right, they have been **authorized** to exercise it.
3. In your section about vets, I would add in that users of tobacco products can't do basic training--no vets if they smoked prior to joining the military. They also can't join the police and fire academies.
4. You changed to "vapor" in the 3rd line under "What about those that want to quit..." I'd keep the same terminology for consistency.
5. I think it is worth mentioning in the FAQ (just like the letter) that this does not impact FDA approved cessation options.

Can we include Diane Stover (pulmonologist) and Ken Elstein (Belchertown BoH member) who have joined our group on future emails.

I'd like to see if I can make a listserv for our group to make it easier..
