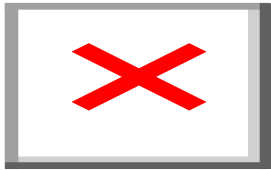

Unlike regular grant applications, which are submitted to federal agencies, cities submit a project proposal directly to their Senators and respective House Member. 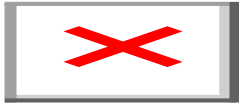
